

حالات الاستعاذة مع البسملة مع السورة

Ways of Seeking refuge with the Basmallah and with the Surah.

There are three situations in which Al-Istiathah is read in Low (or whispering voice). (1) To read in Salaah (prayers) (2) When you read Quraan alone (3) When reading Quraan by turn, the first person should read Al-Istiathah loudly, others can read it in a low voice

(Cutting all three off from each other). Meaning Seeking refuge, stopping, saying the Basmallah, stopping, and then starting the Surah

قطع الجميع / فصل الكل

(Joining all three with each other). Meaning Seeking refuge, saying the Basmallah, and starting the Surah all in one breath without stopping.

وصل الجميع / وصل الكل

(Joining the Basmallah and the beginning of the Surah). This means Seeking refuge, then stopping, then saying the Basmallah, and the beginning of the Surah in one breath.

وصل البسملة بالسورة

(Joining seeking refuge with the Basmallah). This means the seeking of refuge and the Basmallah are joined with one breath then the reader stops then starts the Surah.
